Notice on Chinese Nationals Reporting Health Information for Epidemic Prevention before Flying back to China

Dear GSA, authorized agents,

According to *Notice on Chinese Nationals Reporting Health Information for Epidemic Prevention before Flying back to China* (CAAC [2020] 6) issued by Civil Aviation Administration and General Administration of Customs of People's Republic of China, to prevent the cross-border transmission of the epidemic, **Chinese nationals** having purchased tickets to return to China should report their health information in advance. Detailed requirements are as follows:

1. From 8th Apr, 2020, passengers having purchased tickets should report daily their personal information, health condition, recent travel information, etc. via the Wechat Mini Program of Epidemic Prevention Health Code International Version (防疫健康码国际版). Under special circumstances, others may help with the reporting.

2. Passengers on flights during 8th Apr, 2020 to 22nd Apr, 2020 should report daily the above information from 8th Apr; passengers on flights after 22nd Apr should report daily the above information from 14 days before departure.

3. If passengers fail to report the above information as required, they will be denied boarding. If passengers falsify the information, their trip will be interrupted, while corresponding legal responsibility shall be borne by themselves.

4. These requirements apply to passengers with following countries of departure: Italy, the United States, Spain, Germany, Iran, France, South

Korea, Switzerland, United Kingdom, the Netherlands, Austria, Belgium, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Australia, Brazil, Turkey, Malaysia, Denmark, Canada, Israel, Czech Republic, Ireland, the Philippines and Thailand.

Please promptly notify the Chinese nationals who have purchased tickets to return to China of the above requirements through SMS, Wechat, email, etc.
