
Our Story



In 1977, Joseph Sparling and Tom Wood founded Air North Charter and Training to service the mining industry. Over the following 43 years, that original vision expanded into Air North, Yukon's Airline, now connecting two territories and three provinces with scheduled air passenger and cargo service. Today, Air North is among the largest employers in the Yukon, in addition to having a team in Vancouver. Air North is proud to be a partly Indigenous-owned airline with the Vuntut Gwitchin First Nation's 49% equity ownership. One in 15 Yukoners hold an equity or employment stake in Air North.
