










Nartia Airport Information International Departures



WestJet will operate out of Terminal 1 at the Narita airport. The third level is the International Departures area. Boarding gates are distributed into Satellites 1 to 4.


This level is the next step after the check-in for passengers coming from 4th level, which is where the security checkpoint and passport controls are located, as well as Duty Free Areas.

At the boarding area there is a total of 58 gates divided into the south wing, the north wing and satellites number 1, 2, 3 and 4. All connected, so passengers can go walking everywhere.

Within the Departures area there are all kinds of shops, currency exchange, restaurants, among others.



Calgary Airport Information International Departures



WestJet Airline's flights to Tokyo-Narita departs out of the International terminal (D). Once you've checked-in you will clear security and proceed through the International Departures Hall (D) where you will walk through the Duty-Free shop.

There will be an InfoCentre on the outside of the Duty-Free shop where Customer Care Ambassadors are available to assist with any questions you may have. You can also locate your flight information on one of the many Flight Information Display screens to obtain your gate information.

A large selection of shops, restaurants and services and free Wi-Fi are available in the International Concourse as well.



Calgary Airport Information International Arrivals



Guests connecting to another Canadian destination:

- 1. After arriving at the Calgary airport guests will need to process through Canada Customs before being granted entry into Canada.
- 2. Please follow signs for "Connections"
 - Guest's baggage will be checked to their final destination, so there is no need to collect checked baggage.
- 3. Guests will connect to Domestic gates from behind security by following the "Connections" signage.
- 4.If you require assistance at any point during this process, please see one of our friendly Customer Care Ambassadors stationed throughout the Canada Customs area.

Guests connecting to a U.S. destination:


- 1. After arriving at the Calgary International airport, guests will be considered an "in transit" guest as a result they won't clear Canadian Customs.
- 2. Please follow signs for "Connections"
 - Guest's baggage will be checked to their final destination, so there is no need to collect checked baggage.
- 3. Guests will be directed to the ITPC (International to Pre-Clearance) elevators which will take them upstairs into the U.S. Customs and Border Protection area where the guest will now clear U.S. Customs.
- 4. If you require assistance at any point during this process, please see one of our friendly Customer Care Ambassadors stationed throughout the Canada Customs area.



Lounges

Elevation Lounge-Calgary International Airport

The Westlet Elevation Lounge is located in the Domestic terminal, Concourse B, with access to guests travelling from Concourse A, B or C. Guests departing from Concourse D in the International terminal can access the lounge via security checkpoint B or C before proceeding to Concourse D.
