

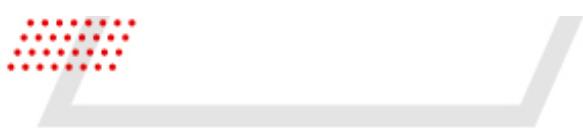

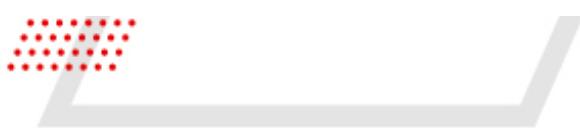

NDC – Book Limo service for NDC offers.

Users can now book limo ground transportation for NDC offers from the mobility and service requests widget. After selection, the user will be prompted to provide additional information such as pick-up time, contact number and address details. Once complete, the limo service will display as an order item in the graphical PNR > Quotes display.

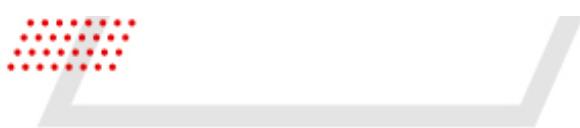


The bundle item is displayed in a drop-down menu, along with the total for each individual bundle. Once selections are made, the combined total for all selected bundles appears in the bottom-right corner of the screen. After saving, the user is returned to the pricing screen, where the widget updates to show "Edit bundles." This allows the user to review or modify their selections.

Next, during the order creation process, the **Bundled Fares** section presents a summary of the selected bundles. Users can also make edits at this stage if needed.

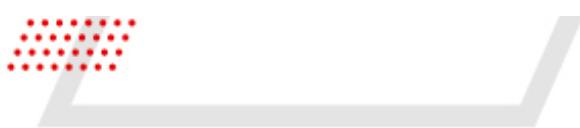

NDC – Change an unfulfilled order.

Users can now modify NDC orders prior to fulfilment. This enhanced workflow leverages familiar patterns from the existing NDC re-shop process, making navigation intuitive and seamless.

To make a change, open the **Trip Summary** panel, navigate to the **Air Segments** section, click the relevant segment, and select **“Change”**.

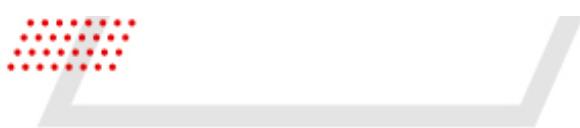

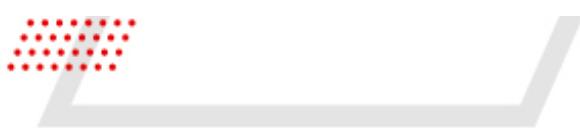
NDC – Change to the cancel confirmation screen for United Airlines flight credit.

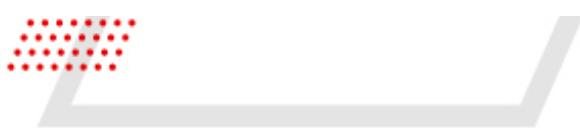

Shop Flights – Shop and filter by seat type.

Users can now apply the new “seat type” shopping qualifier in the Shop Flights workflow. This addition complements existing qualifiers like cabin type and number of stops, enabling users to search for flights and fares that offer specific seat types to better meet traveler needs. Multiple seat types can be included in a single shopping request if desired.

As well as being able to shop by seat type, the user can also filter by the seat type returned in the response when fare upsells are returned.

Note – When seat type information is unavailable, the fare card will show “no data” and the filter will remove the fare showing “no data” when a seat type is selected.

Change workflow – New Compare Fares modal.

Users can now see full brand inclusions and compare them for Sabre fares during the exchange shop process after flight selection. This enhancement brings the exchange shop response closer to the Shop Flights shop response, providing a seamless and familiar experience for the user.

New Cancel workflow extension points

The new extension points are triggered when a Cancel transaction is executed in the graphical Cancel workflow from Trip Summary > Tickets

The new **dynamo.cancel:beforeCancelDocument** extension point is executed before a Cancel request is sent in the graphical Cancel workflow.

The new **dynamo.cancel:afterCancelDocument** extension point is executed after a Cancel response is returned in the graphical Cancel workflow.

Triggered from the graphical path:

- EDIFACT ticket/EMD within the void period
 - Cancel option → Continue → Cancel tickets
- EDIFACT ticket outside of the void period (refund)
 - Cancel option → Continue → Calculate refund → Cancel tickets
- NDC ticket/EMD within the void period
 - Cancel option → Continue → Cancel tickets & keep flights → Cancel tickets
 - Cancel option → Continue → Cancel flights & tickets → Cancel all
- NDC ticket/EMD outside of the void period (refund)
 - Cancel option → Continue → Cancel flights & keep ticket value for future use → Cancel flights
 - Cancel option → Continue → Cancel tickets & keep flights → Cancel tickets
 - Cancel option → Continue → Cancel flights & tickets → Cancel all

OTHER

CO₂ remark configuration in Agency Admin Tool

With this release, you can now configure various CO₂ remark settings—such as time-to-add, amount, remark type, and prefix—using the Agency Admin Tool (AAT) via JSON. All configuration options are optional. However, once any part of the CO₂ workflow is configured in AAT, that portion becomes non-overridable in SR360, both in the settings and within the CO₂ workflow itself.

If an agency wants travel consultants to retain flexibility in how they use CO₂ remarks, configuration through AAT should be avoided.



. In an Agency Admin Tools configuration:

- The "onTransactionEnd" element rules whether the "Add emission remarks on transaction end" check box should be turned ON (true) or OFF (false) in SR360.
- The "perSegmentRemarkStructure" element rules whether the "CO₂ remarks per flight leg (with segment association)" check box should be turned ON (true) or OFF (false) in SR360.
- The "type" element rules which remark type should be pre-configured in the "Remark types" section.
- The "prefix" element defines a custom prefix that will be added to all CO₂ remarks.

Reservation dashboard display

With release 25.9, a new feature called Dashboard has been introduced under the PNR tab. The Dashboard displays all PNRs created in the agent's home PCC using their sine.

When the agent is AAA'd, the Dashboard will show all PNRs created by that agent within their agency.

The dashboard can also be sorted by:

- Start Date (travel date)

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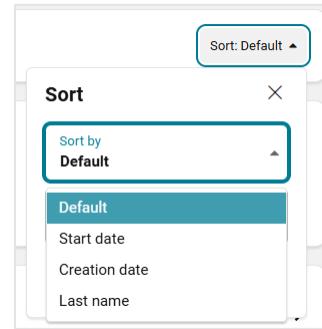
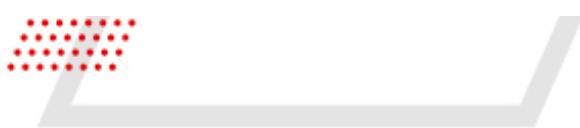
- Creation date (reservation creation date)
- Passenger last name (alphabetical order)

The Dashboard displays recently created PNRs and includes the following details:

- First traveller's name and surname
- Number of travellers
- Phone number and email address, if provided
- PCC and record locator
- Air segments are grouped into a single entry showing:
 - Departure airport code & date
 - Arrival airport code & date
- For multiple segments, the first departure and final arrival details are shown.
- Hotel segments are listed per property and date range; multiple entries may appear.
- Car segments are listed per pick-up/drop-off location and dates; multiple entries may appear if locations or dates differ.

AGENCY ADMIN TOOL

By utilizing the Agency Admin Tool, you are leveraging the flexibility of the Sabre Red 360. You have control over what tools and features your users can see and use within the Sabre Red 360, and you can control the timing of update delivery to your users. This powerful control over the Sabre Red 360 supports the efficiency of your users and your operations.

The date of the release is of importance if you are utilizing the Agency Admin Tool to lock down a set of users to control when the update is delivered to them. The locking function of the Agency Admin Tool is
